

CoRIS is the Coral Reef Conservation Program's (CRCP) information portal that provides access to NOAA coral reef information and data products with emphasis on the U.S. states, territories and remote island areas. NOAA Coral Reef activities include coral reef mapping, monitoring and assessment; natural and socioeconomic research and modeling; outreach and education; and management and stewardship.

User outreach meetings will provide a more in depth overview to CoRIS, answer specific questions and gather feedback on what improvements we can make to CoRIS to improve functionality for the community.

Data & Publication Search



The CoRIS catalog contains more than 11,000 entries and allows users to search for data and publications based on:

- Dates
- Locations
- Text-based Keywords

A series of browsable lists arranged by keywords, publication type and location is also provided.

Direct on-line access to data and publications is provided where available. Under the advanced search options you have the option to restrict you search to on-line data only.
